



Adding Flickr Slideshow to Photos Page on Event Web Site

- 1) Go to www.flickrslideshow.com and enter your event's Flickr account.

Yahoo's photosharing service Flickr is almost certainly the best online photo management and sharing on the web. Flickr Slideshow allows you to easily create a custom flickr slideshow on your website or blog. It is one handy tool; just enter the address of your flickr user page or photo set or group URL address, you will get the HTML embed code at once, copy and paste this html code, one your photo slideshow is ready to show.

Flickr Slideshow can work fine with Blogger, Forums, WordPress, MySpace, Facebook, Live Journal and more. It can find your Flickr user or group id automatically. If you're a fan of Flickr, now you can make your favorite photos as one slideshow by yourself, share it with your family, friends and lover. It is an amazing gift. Flickr Slideshow is a really easy way to embed a nice slide show of your photos off site.

You can use the below form to create one Flickr slide show online, alternate, you can download one free one called "Flickr Slideshow" to create on your pc anytime that you want. The usage is very simple, open your Flickr photo web pages on the Internet Explorer, copy the web page address from the address bar, then paste on the "URL of User, Set or Group", click "Create Slideshow" and you will get one HTML code from your photo album slide show.

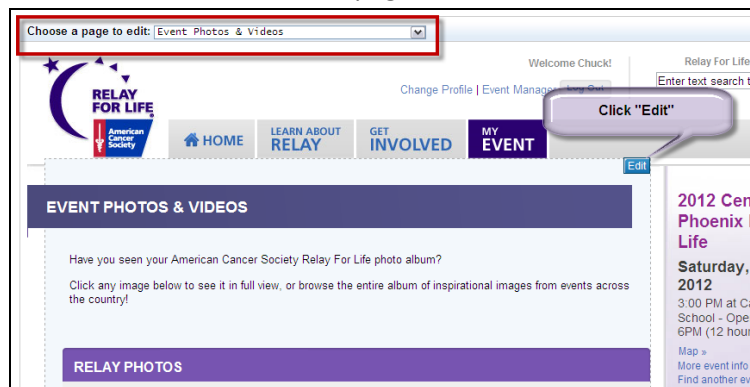

- 2) Click the "Create Slideshow" button; the result of this action is shown below. Copy the iframe code as indicated.

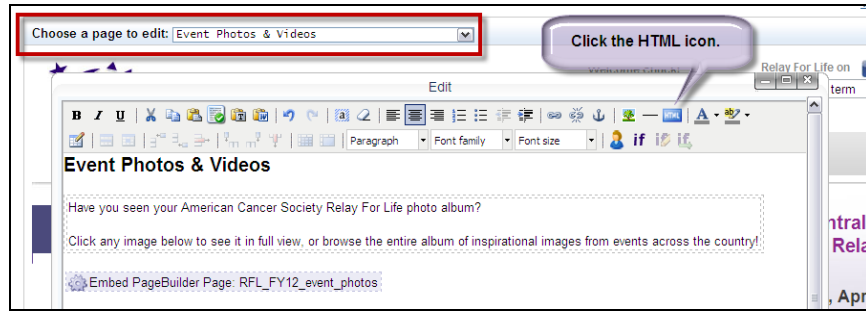


- 3) Login and go to your EMC/Event Web Site page and select "Event Photos & Videos" page from the edit dropdown menu.

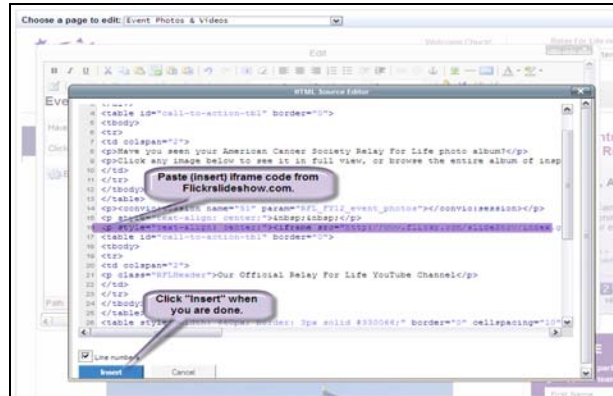
- 4) Once at the "Event Photos & Videos" page click "Edit" as indicated in the image.



- 5) The WYSIWYG editor should appear, click the HTML icon. NOTE: The WYSIWYG/HTML editor does not work well in Safari browser, use FireFox for best results.

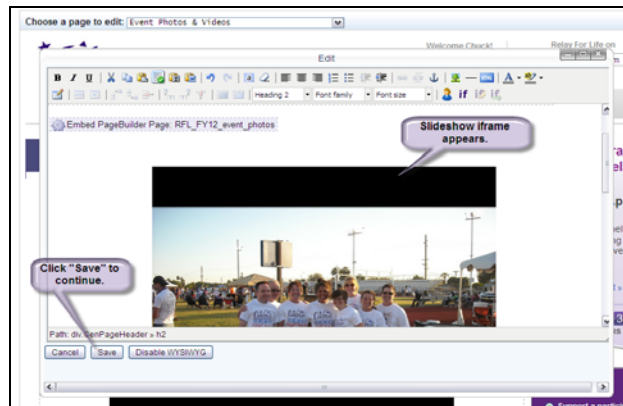


- 6) Paste (insert) the iframe code from Flickrslideshow.com to the appropriate place within your page. Most people will probably want to replace the existing code for a table to display individual photos as in example below. Click



- 7) "Insert" to save your changes.

- 8) Your slideshow should now appear, to complete the process click the "Save" button.



- 9) Finished product should look something like the image below.
